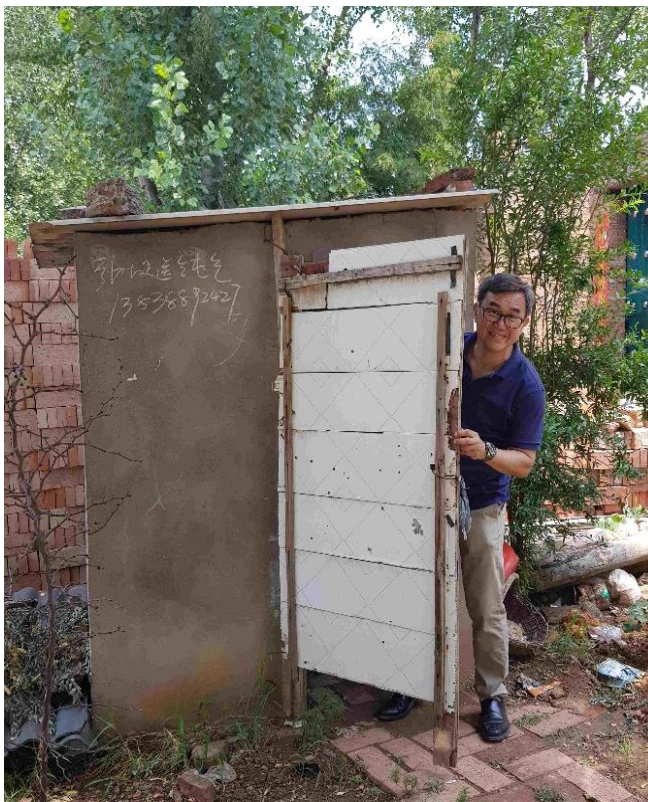


Now is your chance to 'Ask Jack'
