Providing Sustainable Solar Solutions to Rural Communities in Cambodia

Kamworks is a leading solar energy company in Cambodia which provides solar panels and an innovative solar lamp for villagers and offers financing solutions to make these accessible to those living at the base of the economic pyramid.

#### THE OPPORTUNITY

Seventy percent of Cambodians live off the grid, without access to electricity. This means those living without power rely on kerosene lanterns at night. These lanterns are a fire hazard and emit toxic fumes. *Kamworks* realized there was an opportunity to provide a safe and sustainable alternative.

Inclusive businesses address the 4.5 billion people in the world living at the base of the economic pyramid (BOP) by providing much-needed services and seeing them as viable customers. Companies like *Kamworks* provide a necessary service by allowing those at the BOP to invest in solar power through a partnership with a local bank that provides loans.

### THE INCLUSIVE BUSINESS APPROACH

In Cambodia, Kamworks developed a unique inclusive business model by providing solar opportunities which are affordable for rural villagers. Kamworks offers two different products to these communities: a full solar powered system, or a solar-powered lamp called the MoonLight. The MoonLight was developed as a collaboration between Dutch technicians and villagers in a small fishing community outside Phnom Penh. However, even the \$25 cost of the MoonLight is too expensive for most villagers. Therefore, Kamworks has collaborated with a local bank to provide loans alongside the solar installation, providing solutions to help overcome the initial capital cost hurdles. Kamworks also works with local mobile providers to enable mobile money for customer payments and automated and manual SMS and phone call reminders to customers.

Kamworks is partnering with Cambodia Mutual Savings and Credit Network to provide low interest loans to customers to install solar home systems or purchase the MoonLight lantern. The Kamworks office co-houses a branch of the bank, allowing customers to finance their systems and sign up for equipment installation at the same time. Kamworks also works together with Cambodian mobile companies to provide payment systems that can be accessed through customers' mobile phones. Kamworks developed a partnership with WING, the dominant mobile money service in Cambodia, for payment collection and signed a mobile data service agreement with Cellcard, a mobile network operator (MNO).

Our model is to provide financing alongside technical services, to make solar energy accessible while providing safe and sustainable power for rural communities in Cambodia."
